IN ADDITION PLEASE INFORM US AS TO WHETHER AND TO WHAT EXTENT THERE WAS DAMAGE DONE TO THE PROPERTY OF NATIVES BY DRAGS BOATS, WHETHER AND TO WHAT EXTENT THE NATIVES WERE PERMITTED TO REMOVE THEIR PROPERTY FROM THEIR ISLANDS AT THE TIME OF EVACUATION, WHETHER THERE WAS ANY DAMAGE DONE AS A RESULT OF LEAVING PROPERTY ON THE ISLANDS AFTER EVACUATION, WHAT STEPS WERE TAKEN BY YOU TO PROTECT NATIVES' PROPERTY LEFT ON ISLANDS AND WHETHER ANY NEGOTIATIONS HAVE BEEN ENTERED INTO WITH THE NATIVES AS TO COMPENSATION FOR PERSONAL OR PROPERTY INJURY OR DAMAGE.
