I have talked with Dr. J. C. Bugher, Director, Division of Biology and Medicine, Atomic Energy Commission, concerning possible cooperation by the Navy in furnishing transportation of personnel to the biological laboratory which is being planned at Eniwetok. It was his view that before sending a formal request to OMB, it would be best to secure approval of the plan for the laboratory from the Atomic Energy Commission. I fully expect that a request for cooperation on the matter of transportation will be forwarded to Capt. Shilling's office as soon as approval for the project is granted.

It is our understanding that members of the Biology and Hydrobiology Panels will be meeting at the University of Hawaii and would be interested in visiting the Eniwetok area in connection with the proposed biological facility there. The Division of Biology and Medicine is entirely favorable to this and is at this time initiating a request to our security office in Santa Fe that such persons be permitted to visit the area. It is hoped that arrangements can be made for a person from this office to accompany the group.
