Subjects - Rikini Expedition - Early Department

- 1. I had meant to see you this meening about the new Mikind Expedition, but here is the problem in brief.
- A THE STATE OF THE 2. The Navy is sending out three ships, sailing from Sen Francisco about July 1, including an APA for personnel, a gubnarine tender for techmical work, and on LGI for something. The expedition will spend about three weeks at Bikimi. The project is to see what is left, especially from Test Baker.
- The Havy would like to have Br. L. R. Domaldson, of the University of Washington, tegether with a group of about ten of his people, as members of the party. Since Dr. Donaldson is working on an ABC contract, could this trip be considered a part of the contract and paid for by the ABC? Total cost is estimated at about \$25,000.
- 4. The Navy also needs a half dozen rello-chemists. They partieslarly want Roy Overstreet and Lewis Jacobson from the University of Galiformia. The University is not enthusiastic. Mr. Forrestal has written to President Sproul. Would Mr. Lilienthal be ailling to write to President Sproul? A suggested draft letter is on the way from the levy.
- The Havy also needs authorisation, and probably some help, in connection with the other four radio-chemists. Particularly they want to proselyte at Argonne and Clinton. In this connection, can the University of Galifornia contract accept these half dozen people?
- Commander Revelle is the interested party in the Navy Department. I have promised to give him enswers to his questions. You will see that the time factor is urgest.
