TO WINKOOP INFO TURNER, HERTFORD, LUEDECKE FROM STARKERD

AUTHORITY HAS BEEN GRANTED THE AIR FORCE TO UTILIZE ENIWETOK AND BIKINI
IN CONNECTION WITH ACCOMPLISHING A MIRAN SURVEY IN THE MID PACIFIC. IT
WILL BE NECESSARY TO HOUSE FOUR AIR FORCE PERSONNEL, SHELTER 2,000 POUNDS
OF EQUIPMENT AND ERECT A SMALL RADIO ANTENNA AT EACH ^{ATOLL} ISLAND FOR A PERIOD
OF 90 DAYS. PRESENT PLANS INDICATE NOVEMBER 1, 1958 AS THE "IN PLACE
DATE" FOR THIS PROJECT.

PARA. NECESSARY MILITARY CLEARANCES WILL BE PROCESSED BY CJTF-7 SINCE
ACCESS TO ATOMIC ENERGY INFORMATION WILL NOT BE REQUIRED.

PARA. THE AIR FORCE UNIT WILL BE SELF-SUPPORTING AND WILL NOT REQUIRE THE
USE OF AEC FACILITIES. HOWEVER, ANY ASSISTANCE THAT CAN BE RENDERED WITHIN
MEANS AVAILABLE SHOULD BE OFFERED, PROVIDED THAT NO ADDITIONAL FUNDING IS
NECESSARY.
