Dear Mr Eisenbud:

Two 24 hour urine collections were made for analysis at the NYOO Laboratory. The first collection was completed and shipped on 24 March. The second collection was made completed on 25 March and shipment was made on 29 March.

The identification mark on each urine bottle consists of the patient's name, the date of collection, and the patient's clinical number. ( For example: 316-45 indicates the 24 hour collection was begun on 15 march and terminated on 16 march for patient number 45.)

The accompanying tablets contain the total urine volumes collected on 24 and 25 march.


Previous dispatch on dates of collection was accidentally in error.

The urine has been collected, acidified, packaged, and shipped to all interested laboratories, ( U S N R D L and Los Alamos ) by Lt. W. H Chapman (MSC) USN and Lt(jg) R. Sharp (MSC)USN. I am confident that all urine was handled in an identical manner and that interlaboratory comparisons should be reasonable and would give different times to evaluate excretion rates.

Chickens shipped to NRDL have shown highly significant internal deposition as shown by radiatographs. Preliminary report on urine from Los Alamos indicates present of plutonium.

It would be appreciated if studies were made on excretion of bones seekers and if this project, through CJIF-7, could be regularly informed of status on urine analysis so we can logically plan subsequent studies on fission products and long term follow up studies of exposed personnel.
