We sincerely appreciate your September 18, 1958 letter permitting Cooper Development Corporation to use LOKI loading and processing equipment for the benefit of our AEC work.

The purpose of this letter is to request your approval of Jet Propulsion Laboratory loaning Cooper Development Corporation necessary loading and processing tooling to enable Cooper to fabricate and have loaded RTV motors should tests which will occur in the next few days prove that RTV motors are necessary for our program.

As stated in previous correspondence and conversations, time is of the essence in execution of our Subcontract 108 with Cooper Development Corporation under our Prime Contract W-7405-eng-48 with the Atomic Energy Commission.
