Dear Dr. Bugher:

We are forwarding the data which we have been able to collect on the patients whom we have examined. It is admittedly incomplete and patchy. Supplemental data will be forwarded to you as soon as we have opportunity to study the other patients and to complete our studies on those we have already seen. The patients will now be in two hospitals in Tokyo. It will be necessary for us to get additional personnel from ABCC in order to make this study. Japanese authorities have promised to give us permission to examine patients. We will proceed as soon as possible with the examination when we get authority. We hope to complete our studies within a week but it may not be possible. We checked the differential counts on the two Tokyo patients by taking material from them and making our own preparations. The check was very nearly similar to their counts which makes us believe that their differentials are good.


