Procedural - 1958

Reference is made to letter, file SURFSG 357, this headquarters, 3 April 1956; letter, your office, 19 April 1956; and letter, file SURFSG 357, this headquarters, 25 July 1956, which concerned the establishment of an emergency medical team to be called in the event of a contaminating disaster during Operation REDWING, and the eventual disestablishment of the team with the termination of the operation.

Although it is unlikely that a contaminating event such as CASTLE-Bravo in March 1954, will occur during Operation HARBACK, it has been informally agreed by all concerned that it would be wise to re-establish an emergency medical team which could give assistance and perform studies on any people affected.

It is requested that the following persons be placed on an alert basis during the period 1 April 1958 to 1 September 1958 to participate on an emergency medical team which is being formed under Joint Task Force SEVEN. It is further requested that if your office concurs in this request, that Joint Task Force SEVEN be so informed of the concurrence and the names of the individuals, with a copy to this headquarters.
