At Meeting 978 on April 21, 1954, in the course of a discussion of the fall-out incident involving Japanese fishermen, the Chairman said that at his earliest convenience he would discuss with the Undersecretary of State, General Bedell Smith, the desirability of issuing a statement concerning Japanese non-cooperation with American medical and technical officials. The Chairman indicated that he wished to be reminded of this matter.

2. At approximately 4:45 on the afternoon of Wednesday, April 21, 1954, this office telephoned the Chairman's office and informed Miss Morris that the Chairman wished to be reminded to make this call and requested her to call the matter to his attention.
