To BRIG GEN FIELDS from MAJ GEN CLARKSON. SUBJECT is PATE PALMER REPORT. GRAVELS still strongly objects to distribution of subject report to Joint Congressional Committee on Atomic Energy due to its controversial nature; therefore as CJTF 7 I have not approved the report and am opposed to this proposed distribution. Please refer to my letter ^{DMA-4} to you on this subject dated 11 January. Copy number one of report on hand here, no additional copies available. Am not aware of any comments by MAYNARD; if he makes any he should take them to CJTF 7. There is no objection to loan of copy of report to qualified Weather Bureau Personnel. Information asee please recall copy on loan to you if required for this purpose. I have no comments at this time concerning weather effects anticipated in CASTLE. We are already planning to investigate and prepare a report on effect of detonations on weather. CJTF 7 will advise results of this investigation even if negative report. Report by CJTF 7 on this subject will be distributed after conclusion of CASTLE.
