

Dear Gene,

I enclose the copy of the text of a paper we have first sent off to the "Lancet". I thought this would interest you as we have carried the initial observations of Fliedner, yourself and others a bit further by doing serial chromosome counts on the irradiated individual.

The result, frankly, has surprised us and the magnitude of the effect with a single exposure of 250 rads to the skin over the spinal column gives grounds for hoping that we may make observations over quite a range of dose.
