

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, hereinafter called the Trust Territory, represented by J. F. Screen, Contracting Officer for the High Commissioner, and the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, hereinafter called AEC, represented by William A. Bonnet, Honolulu Area Manager, concerning the carrying out of certain AEC responsibilities in the Marshall Islands, particularly those connected with the special examinations of the Marshallese people who were exposed to fallout, reflects the following agreements and understandings of the parties hereto:

1. Wherever possible the AEC will coordinate travel within the Marshall Islands District in connection with the above matters with normal Trust Territory field trip operations. Charges reimbursable to the Trust Territory by AEC shall reflect only those costs to the Trust Territory over and above normal field trip and trading operations incurred by Trust Territory in supporting the AEC obligation in the operation.

2. If determined by AEC that a Marshallese patient be transported to the U. S. for special medical treatment, the Trust Territory will make necessary travel arrangements between home island and Ebeye, provide proper documentation for entry into the U. S., including subsistence, clothing and housing arrangements at Ebeye. AEC will furnish necessary orders for travel on MAC aircraft from Kwajalein to Honolulu and return.

3. The costs incurred by the Trust Territory in carrying out its obligations under paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be reimbursable to the Trust Territory by AEC.

4. It is understood that the AEC request for services contemplated above will be through its prime contractor by purchase order issued on a fiscal basis with a monetary limitation included.

It is understood that this Agreement shall become effective on September, 15, 1966 and shall continue in force unless superseded or cancelled at the request of either party.
