

RE: LETTER OF INSTRUCTION,
RONGELAP-WOTHO MISSION

DATE: 7 March 1958

Reference: TEE:EW:H-5653

You are hereby designated as senior member of all personnel of the H&N Group to be engaged in rehabilitation and reactivation of the Rad-Safe Stations at Sites-Rongelap and Wotho.

As such, you will have authority to:

Perform all necessary work in connection with activation of these stations, including offloading of the ship and transfer and storage of equipment.

Establish and administer rules and regulations pertaining to personnel conduct while ashore which will insure continuing good relations with Trust Territory and native personnel.

The LST 618 will depart Eniwetok on or about 1600 hours on Monday, 10 March 1958 and will arrive at Rongelap about 0700 hours on Wednesday, 12 March. The LST will depart Rongelap about 1600 hours on Saturday, 15 March, arriving at Wotho about 0700 hours on Sunday, 16 March. The return trip to Eniwetok will depart Wotho about 1500 hours on Wednesday, 19 March, arriving at Eniwetok about 1700 hours on Thursday, 20 March.

Your group will consist of the personnel listed on the attached sheet. Personnel who are scheduled to remain at Sites-Rongelap and Wotho are indicated as groups (1) and (2) on the attached sheet; all other personnel will return to this site upon completion of mission.
