Earlier this year I notified you of the forthcoming publication of two books carrying medical reports on the effects of the atomic bomb in Japan and on the Marshallese captured by fallout in the early series of tests. The book carried the report on medical effects of the atomic bomb in Japan was published in the summer of 1949. I am enclosing a copy of it for your information.

Supplies of the volume were sent to some United States technical and book outlets by McGraw-Hill, the publisher of the book, as part of a campaign other than the usual war-time government literature program. This is planned by the publisher.
