1. Statement with regard to Antarctica. The group discussed the statement disclaiming the existence of any U.S. base in Antarctica as a base for the development of a permanent base. The statement discussed, and the U.S. report on the subject was widely discussed, with the exception of minor language changes, the statement was considered to be unobjectionable.
