An Ad Hoc Committee of the Working Group met with the State Desk Officer of the State Department, Mr. Philip M. Canine, on Japan, to discuss a proposed announcement of an IAEA survey in the Pacific which had been received from the State Officer by Admiral Foster, Special Agent in Charge, on this date. After discussion, it was announced that the full text of the proposed announcement would be sent to the United States Embassy in Tokyo as a matter of courtesy to the Japanese Government for release if the Japanese government found it appropriate. It was agreed that no further action with regard to the timing of the announcement would be taken until further information had been received. It was estimated that such information would be received by Monday, April 11.
