that area. Following return ship Japan March 14 report by Japanese authorities stated crew members ill and showed skin burns from radiation. Japanese physicians gave crew members medical treatment. Medical assistance offered Japanese by U.S. through Amembassy Tokyo. Japanese have not (repeat not) yet called for such assistance. However, they did request U.S. aid in making chemical analyses of some urine samples. These were performed at Commission laboratories. Injured men are reported by Japanese physicians be improving satisfactorily.

It is regretted crewmen of FUKURYU MARU were injured as result being exposed to radiation from first detonation of recently concluded series. Welfare of patients will continue to be of interest to U.S., and negotiations for settlement this incident being handled through Department of State and Amembassy Tokyo. This connection Ambassador Allison informed Japanese Government U.S. would pay just compensation and also would reimburse injured fishermen for reasonable expenses for current medical care and family relief, including wages. UNQUOTE.
