Results analyses specimens given Department telegram 2357 correct. Since first specimens (reported Department telegram 2199) taken from different patients, possible explain wide range in figures in terms of radiation dosage received by different individuals. Felt unwise draw conclusions from these data alone.

No precautions needed by American personnel handling specimens in which radioactivity no greater than that indicated.
