Reference Embassy's 3208.

1. President Kaya of Japan Science Council has sent word to Boss through Hiyama, who strongly endorsed message, that it is most important that acceptance conference invitation for this fall be made public at this time. Failure to do so would play into hands unfriendly elements here; have adverse effect on public opinion; and seriously retard developing trend here for improved scientific cooperation. They urge Embassy make appropriate press release confirming fall conference.

2. Embassy endorses suggestion. As essential elements press release should conform to Embassy note accepting invitation, we have delayed delivery and will informally advise Foreign Office our intentions along lines reference telegram, promising send formal note soonest after receipt Department and AEC instruction re proposed public statement.

3. Please instruct urgently substance or text of press release which we can issue here regarding AEC-Japan science council meeting this fall.

4. Boss-Donaldson informal meeting with Hiyama and associates will be held here June 30. They leave July 1 for Eniwetok.
