2. In event death, propose release immediately appropriate statement sorrow, sympathy. Assume Department will release statement for Secretary transmitted in rough draft MacTurkin to Berger letter May 7.

3. To expedite local distribution, would appreciate confirmation text in advance and arrangements notify us immediately on its release. Suggest rewording final sentence draft to eliminate unqualified reference to compensation possibility by substitution "We remain ready to do everything we possibly can do to alleviate the suffering caused by these accidents and to promote the recovery of the unfortunate patients".
