U. S. EMBASSY JAPAN ADVISED ON APRIL SIXTEEN THAT ATOM BOMB INJURY INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE OFFERED COLLECT TWENTY FOUR HOUR URINE SAMPLES MONDAY EACH WEEK FOR ALL TWENTY THREE PATIENTS AND DELIVER TO EMBASSY REPRESENTATIVE EACH TUESDAY. DELIVERY SAMPLES SUBJECT TO FOLLOWING CONDITIONS LAID DOWN BY JAPANESE:
(A) U. S. TO COMMUNICATE RESULTS; (B) U. S. TO NOTIFY JAPANESE NAMES PATIENTS WHOSE URINE NO LONGER QUOTE REQUIRE END QUOTE EXAMINATION; (C) U. S. NOT REPEAT NOT TO PUBLISH RESULTS WITHOUT PRIOR CONSULTATION INJURY INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE.
RE ANALYTICAL SERVICE ORIGINALLY OFFERED BY EISENHARDT IF JAPANESE DOCTORS DESIRED. NOTE ALSO JAPANESE OFFER DOES NOT REPEAT NOT MENTION BLOOD COUNT AND OTHER CLINICAL DATA PREVIOUSLY PROMISED DR. MORTON AND REQUESTED BY YOU.

AMBASSADOR ALLISON INQUIRES WHETHER AEC INTERESTED THIS OFFER WITH QUOTE ITS CONTINUED IMPLICATION WE ARE CONCERNED NOT WITH RECOVERY PATIENTS BUT WITH MEDICAL INTELLIGENCE END QUOTE.
