Commission Decisions

1. AEC 879/3 - Power Demonstration Reactor Program - Yankee Atomic Electric Company Proposal - The Commission accepted your recommendation to request clarification of Yankee's SEC testimony before taking action. (Davis)
2. AEC 720/20 - Revision in Base Price of Thorium Metal - Approved as revised. (Burrows)
3. AEC 47/12 - Nuclear Propulsion Plants for Submarine and Surface Ship Application - Approved. A paper is to be submitted as soon as possible on assignment of the guided missile cruiser project. (Davis)
4. Amendment to U. S. - U. K. Agreement for Cooperation - Approved. The additional article disclaiming liabilities was also approved; however, the exact text is to be determined in consultation with State. (Hall - Mitchell)
5. AEC 882 - Use of AEC-Owned Facilities for Private Purposes by Edgerton, Germeshausen & Grier, Inc. - Approved subject to satisfactory report of a security inspection. (Starbird)
6. AEC 599/8 - Supplementary U. K. Request for 20 Tons of Heavy Water - Approved. (Hall)
7. AEC 616/20 - Revised Budget Request for Sodium Graphite Reactor Program - Approved if Mr. Nichols made a commitment to NAA; however, if he did not, the paper is to be resubmitted. Please inform us when you determine whether Mr. Nichols made a commitment so that we can ask the staff to take appropriate action. (Davis)
8. AEC 23/34 - Regulations for Licensing of Production and Utilization Facilities - Approved. The press release is to be revised. A staff paper is to be submitted on the question of whether AEC should require proof of minimum assets for public liability claims. (Price)

10. AEC 809/27 - Proposed Regulation "Unclassified Activities in Foreign Atomic Energy Programs" - Approved as revised. A digest of reports is to be circulated periodically. (Price)

Means of publishing the policy to revoke clearance of persons going abroad are to be examined. (Mitchell)
