Commission Action

1. AEC 508/20 - Draft of Additional Power Agreement with OVEC - Approved. The letter to the JCAE is to be revised. (Bloch)

Mr. Murray requested that the "mutually satisfactory" clause be clarified with OVEC through an exchange of letters.

2. Agenda - The next Commission meeting is scheduled for February 21.

Other Business

1. NSC Meeting - Mr. Strauss reported on his attendance at an NSC meeting at which AEC 655/42 - Report on the Background and Status of the Small Output Civilian Power Reactor - was discussed.

2. Observers for REDWING - Mr. Strauss said that DOD was considering British and Canadian military observers for REDWING.

The paper you indicated was forthcoming is to include a statement from the General Counsel on whether the presence of foreign military observers at REDWING involves communication of Restricted Data. (Mitchell)

A determination is to be made on whether steps should be taken to legalize the attendance of Canadian observers at Operation TEAPOT. (Mitchell)

3. Redesignation of SFOO - Mr. Strauss suggested that SFOO be designated Santa Fe-Albuquerque Operations Office for one year and thereafter ~~be known~~ be known as the Albuquerque Operations Office.

4. Mr. Murray's Position on Yankee - Mr. Murray's memorandum is to be appended to the Minutes of Meeting 1174.

5. Military Requirements - You reported on your conversation with General Loper and added that a letter from DOD would be received next week.
