Commission Decisions

1. AEC 867/10 - Proposed Revision of Transfer and Dispersal Directive - Approved. A letter from the DOD is to be obtained clarifying their letter to us. (Starbird)
  2. AEC 580/38 -- Draft Letter to Secretary of Defense Regarding Military Requirements - Approved, as revised. (Starbird)
  3. AEC 895 - Nuclear Metals Inc., Proposal to Transfer AEC Work to Private Facilities - Approved. You are to review the contract. (Davis)
  4. AEC 751/49 - Position of the U. S. on Plutonium Derived from Foreign and Domestic Power Reactors - Not approved. Mr. Murray's motion was not approved. However, the Commission agreed to endorse a revision to the applicable part of the proposed IAEA statute. This decision and Mr. Murray's position are to be informally communicated to State Department. (Hall)
  5. AEC 226/76 - U. N. Scientific Committee on Radiation (Discussion) - The Commission had no objection to the proposals. Mr. Strauss referred to the need for assurance that no classified material is inadvertently provided the U.N., and to the desirability of AEC, rather than the U.N., providing this type of information to the public. (Dunham)
- A syllabus on additional material needed to up-date the "Report on Effects of High Yield Weapons" is to be prepared. (Dunham)
6. AEC 751/52 - Gift of U-235 to Proposed IAEA - A statement for the President is to be prepared for consideration by the Commission. (Hall)
  7. Expenditure of Fissionable Material at REDWING - The Commission approved an additional request to the President for authorization to expend one kilogram of U-233. (Starbird)
  8. Minutes - Approved as submitted.
