
Dr. Libby asked to be provided the technical analysis concerning estimates of future chemical processing costs, before the staff paper is submitted. (Davis)


4. Research - Dr. Libby requested a report on the theories for additional neutrons observed in controlled thermonuclear research. (Johnson)
