Subject: COMMISSION DECISIONS FROM MARCH 26 TO APRIL 6, 1956

We thought you might like a brief summary of Commission decisions and other items of information during the period March 26 to April 6, 1956.

Meeting 1188 - March 28, 1956

1. AEC 903 - Action in the Field of Atomic Energy to Encourage Integration of the Community of Six - Approved, as revised. Mr. Hall has been requested to obtain your comments.

The revised version of this paper has been circulated as AEC 903/1, and after review by the Commissioners, will be forwarded to the Department of State on April 10.

2. AEC 226/79 - Draft Letter to Mr. Stassen Commenting on Disarmament Study - Approved as revised. Mr. Foster suggested that Mr. Strauss ascertain whether a recent Department of State position paper on the question of a test moratorium agreement reflects Messrs. Dulles' and Hoover's views. Your memorandum of March 26, 1956, on this subject will be incorporated into the record.

3. AEC 787/24 - Joint AEC-DOD Information Plan for Operation REDWING - Approved. The Commission also approved declassification of the approximate date of the first shot.

4. AEC 603/28 - High Energy Accelerators on University Sites - Approved.

5. AEC 529/7 - Revesting Title to Minerals at the Moab, Utah Site - The General Manager's action was approved.

6. AEC 883/2 - Proposed Legislation Authorizing AEC to Reimburse New Employees for Travel and Moving Expenses - Approved.

7. AEC 780/3 - Annual AEC Honor Awards Ceremony - Noted with approval.

8. Items of Information

Construction of Reactor at LASL - A study on the desirability and feasibility of AEC constructing a power reactor at LASL is to be prepared.

Commissioner Vance will attend the First REDWING Shot.

Cornerstone Ceremonies at New Headquarters - A routine ceremony will be held.

Changes in Transfer Directive - The Commissioners were informed of the President's revision and approval of the Weapons Transfer Directive.

103rd AEC-MLC Conference, March 29, 1956

The Conference consisted mainly of a briefing on Cooperative U.S.-Canadian Efforts in Air Defense. General Loper commented on the possible trends in air defense, including the possibility of cooperation in the use of nuclear weapons.

Agenda Planning Session, March 30, 1956

Mr. Libby referred to the possibility that appropriations hearings would be held during the last two weeks of April or the first week of May and suggested that since Mr. Strauss and Mr. Vance would be away, it was vital that the other Commissioners be available during this period because of the possible need for them to testify on the AEC FY 1957 budget.

The Commissioners also discussed the relative status of U. S. and U.S.S.R. thermonuclear weapons development.
