2. Operation REDWING Report (pp. 3-5)

5-3-56

Colonel O'Bryan briefly reported on the status of Operation REDWING.

He said that Senator Pastore, the only member of JCAE attending the CHEROKEE Shot, had departed earlier in the day for the proving grounds. He also reported that the weather looked favorable, and that the test facilities and experiments were ready for the LACROSSE Shot, and that the CHEROKEE Shot was scheduled for May 7.

Mr. Salisbury then reported on the arrangements for public media coverage of the LACROSSE and CHEROKEE Shots.
