Dear General Loper:

This is in answer to your letter of April 27, 1956, which enclosed material for briefing foreign observers at Operation REDWING. You state your belief that the material, if it involves Restricted Data, is of a type clearly transmissible to the United Kingdom and Canada and request concurrence of the Atomic Energy Commission in the use of the material for briefing the foreign observers.

We have reviewed the material you enclosed and have determined that it does not contain Restricted Data relating to the design or fabrication of atomic weapons. We concur in its use for briefing the foreign observers and believe that a joint determination by the AEC and DOD under Section 114b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 is not required.
