3. AEC 745/7, AEC 746/8, AEC 746/9 - Program Status Report, June 30, 1955 (pp. 52-71)

With regard to AEC 746/9, Mr. Libby suggested that experience gained from Operation TEAPOE be summarized under the section of the report dealing with this Operation. Mr. Murray also pointed out that the Commission had not yet taken action on a test during 1957, and requested that reference to tests scheduled beyond Operation REDWING be deleted. He added that he did not believe the present AEC test program was adequate, and that it might be necessary to form a second test group so that test operations may be conducted sooner.

Approved, as revised, for transmittal to the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy, the Program Status Report attached as an Enclosure to AEC 745/7, and Parts II (Special Nuclear Materials) and III (Weapons) to the report, being circulated as AEC 746/8 and AEC 746/9, respectively.
