IF THEY ARE AS REPRESENTED, THEY APPEAR TO BE A BREACH OF SECURITY. WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT YOU HAVE ISSUED ADEQUATE SECURITY INSTRUCTIONS; HOWEVER, WE HAVE AN URGENT NEED FOR A COMPLETE BREAKDOWN OF IMPLEMENTING INSTRUCTIONS BY YOUR SUBORDINATE COMMANDERS. I AM PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN THE MANNER IN WHICH INSTRUCTIONS WERE DISSEMINATED IN CONNECTION WITH ORAL STATEMENTS AND LETTER WRITING.




