FOR GEN MCCORMACK INFO TO SPENCE. CITE TEST DIRECTOR TWO ZERO THREE SUGAR ONE FIZE. THIS IS PROGRESS REPORT NUMBER THREE FOR PERIOD ONE FIVE TO TWO TWO MARCH. TASK FORCE ARRIVED ENIVETOK SIXTEEN MARCH. FOUR PRINCIPAL SHIPS NOW ANCHORED OFF ENGEBI. UNLOADING STARTED IMMEDIATELY AND IS ON SCHEDULE. ALL INSTRUMEN-TATION INSTALLATIONS PROCEEDING ON SCHEDULE WITH EXCEPTION OF TECHNICAL PHOTO FACILITIES WHICH ARE BEING PUSHED. HULL AND STAFF HAVE VISITED ALL SITES AND EXPRESSED COMPLETE SATISFACTION. EN-GINEERS HAVE DONE A CREDITABLE JOB. POOR COMMUNICATIONS HAVE TAMPERED ADMINISTRATIVE OPERATIONS SOMEWHAT. SPIRIT OF SOME MEMBERS OF SCIENTIFIC GROUP DAMPENED BY SUBMARINE ALERT SECOND NIGHT IN PORT. WORLD NEWS CONTRIBUTING FACTOR. PROBLEM DISCUSSED WITH COMMANDER WHO WERE ADVISED THAT NUMEROUS ALERTS WOULD INTER-FERE WITH ACCOMPLISHMENT OF TASK IN HAND. UNNECESSARY ALERTS WILL BE AVOIDED. POST SANDSTONE SECURITY PROBLEM UNSOLVED. IS SUBJECT OF SEPARATE MESSAGE. BEGINNING DISCUSSIONS WITH JOINT TASK FORCE SEVEN ON PRESS RELEASES AFTER SHOTS. ANY WASHINGTON AEC GUIDANCE WOULD BE HELPFUL. WE FEEL THAT DETONATION WILL BECOME PUBLICLY KNOWN WITHIN SEVERAL DAYS OF EVENT.
