Attached are six copies of the Joint Information Plan for Operation REDWING as approved by the Atomic Energy Commission. This draft has been discussed with members of your staff and modifications were included as suggested by the Department of Defense, with the exception that it provides for Forward Area Information Advisers from DOD and AEC to the Commander, JTF-7, with which the Commander now concurs.

We would appreciate having your concurrence as soon as possible in order to place the Joint Office of Test Information (JOTI) on active status with your assistance.

The Plan itself is designed to permit flexibility in recommendations made by the JOTI and, with the exception of fallout reporting within the continental United States, it provides that any information issued publicly shall be approved by the Office of the Secretary of Defense and the Atomic Energy Commission, and coordinated with such other Executive Departments and Agencies as may have an interest especially in the field of international relations.
