DECISION ON AEC 787/20
OFFICIAL OBSERVER PROGRAM FOR REDWING

Note by the Secretary

At Meeting 1186 on March 20, 1956, the Commission:

a. Approved the Official Observer Program for REDWING as proposed in AEC 787/17 and as modified in paragraph 9 c of AEC 787/20;
