Dear Senator Anderson:

As you know, Operation REDWING, the 1956 test series in the Pacific, is scheduled to start about the first of May and to extend thereafter for a period of two and one-half months or more.

It is my hope that you, and as many other members as possible of the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy, will be able to see one of the shots. By separate letters I am extending individual invitations to the other members of your Committee. So that we may work out tentative plans for travel and accommodations, I would appreciate information as early as practical as to whether you may be able to attend and an indication of the probable period most suitable to you.

Generally, you may expect to be away from Washington a minimum of ten days including travel time. The length of absence, however, might be extended by delay of the shot for weather or operational reasons. Of course, every effort would be made to reschedule departure from Washington whenever possible, in order to reduce the length of the trip.

Again, may I express my hope that you will be able to attend.
