DR. FUGHER AND MYSELF THIS DATE WERE REQUESTED BY THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON ATOMIC ENERGY TO APPEAR BEFORE THEM TO EXPLAIN THE FALLOUT SITUATION. WHILE THE INFORMATION FURNISHED IN YOUR 030010Z WAS HELPFUL AND THINGS ARE PRESENTLY QUIET, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT WE RECEIVE AT AN EARLY DATE THE REPORT REQUESTED IN MY MESSAGE 061746Z.

PARAGRAPH. IN ADDITION I NEED BROAD INFORMATION ON PRESENT OPERATIONAL CONDITIONS PREVAILING AT THE PROVING GROUNDS. HAVE HAD LITTLE. WHAT I NEED IS SUMMARY REPORT SUCH AS YOUR 72 HOUR REPORT ON MIKE. MUST HAVE SUCH INFORMATION AS CONDITION OF SCIENTIFIC STRUCTURES, PARTICULARLY THE [REDACTED] SITE, EFFECTS OF BRAVO SUCH AS CRATER AND BLAST DAMAGE, ESTIMATE AS TO PERCENT OF PLANNED SCIENTIFIC DATA THAT WILL BE OR HAS BEEN RECOVERED, AND A GENERAL PICTURE OF THE RADIOLOGICAL SITUATION AS IT AFFECTS PRESENT AND FUTURE OPERATIONS.
