FROM TOKYO REPORTING TWO JAPANESE FISHING VESSELS OUTSIDE DANGER AREA
ARRIVED IN PORT WITH RADIOACTIVE TUNA AND SOME OF CATCH WAS DESTROYED
AND CONTAMINATED. NO ILLNESS REPORTED AMONG CREWS. VESSELS REPORTEDLY
SHOWED RADIOACTIVITY. THIS INFORMATION UNCONFIRMED BY ANY OFFICIAL
SOURCES. STATE DEPARTMENT HAS RECEIVED NO OFFICIAL JAPANESE REACTION.
