1. PERSONNEL

2. SHOT OPERATIONS

- 0530 - Aspen detonated.
- 0630 - Walnut detonated.
- 0930 - R-hour announced.
- 0850 - Rad-Safe survey took off.
- 0930 - 2 rockets fired from Wilma, 4 from Sally.
- 1105 - Aspen flyaway #1 airborne.
- 1655 - Walnut flyaway #1 airborne after 2 unsuccessful attempts.

3. RECOVERY

Recovery operations went well. Two nose cones and one filmpack recovered **BY** 1302. Project 2.4 called off recovery operations due to high level of radiation. Will try again tomorrow.
