1. EVACUATION and RE-ENTRY:

Major Sill was queried concerning the possibility of not evacuating the Oboe camps for the MAPLE event. The question came up as a result of a telephone conversation between Cols Pinson and Lucke. Sill states that there is no intention at present of UCRL evacuating the Oboe camp for MAPLE. The blast and thermal values are predicted to be negligible and they will not evacuate the area unless a fallout problem comes up. (EAP)

For the units a Hickam Air Force Base, transportation will be furnished by the Motor Pool rather than checking out vehicles to various projects in order to provide more effective utilization of the limited number of vehicles available. (EAL)






