The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you of a Commission views on organisation for Operation Sandstone and a of the reasons underlying the Commission's decision to make a broad delegation of authority to the Test Director.

se considered initially the basic question of the retionship in the field between the Commission's Director and the Military Commander. We felt that if the test was to be a sele success it would be necessary for the Commission's Director to full freedom of action in technical matters. We also recognize that we were dealing with an everseas expedition, with imports military operational aspects, hence it would be necessary to a overall command authority in the Military Commander.

After discussing this question with General Hull, we were convinced that tim Commission's scientific and technical terests would not be prejudieed in any way by placing the Commission's Director under General Hull's over-all control. We accome ingly appointed as Test Director Captain Russell, a military assigned to the Commission, and by agreement with the Joint Cl of Staff placed him under General Hull's operational command. are aware of the details of assignment of responsibility as as upon in the joint operational plan.

The Los Alamos Laboratory, a contractor's organisati is charged with the conduct of the scientific test. A group i the Laboratory, under Dr. Fromen, in direct charge of test act ties, is sutherized by the Laboratory Director to report on te matters directly to Captain Russell as the Commission's repres

The Commission is satisfied with these arrangements fitting together for field service a joint military command, a Commission organisation, and an organization from one Commission contractor which encompasses technical personnel from several ment and private agencies.



decisions necessary to efficiency in a very difficult operation. The three exceptions are those:

- a. The Commission, on recommendation from the Test Director, and with counsel from the General Advisory Committee and the Military Limison Committee, will approve the general plan for the test, including particularly the planned sequence of shots, with variations forescen as possible.
- b. Release of information to the public regarding the test will be made only from Mashington.
- o. The Test Director may, at his discretion, ask decisions from the Commission on any other matter.

In connection with the first of these three points, the final comments of the General Advisory Committee on this matter will be available by December 31. It is necessary that the Commission's decision be rendered not later than January 10.
